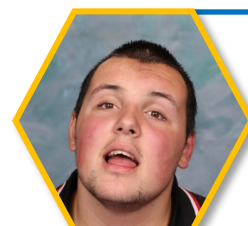

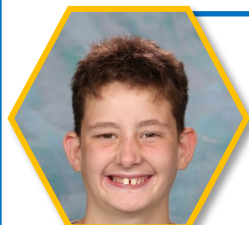

Remember - the Canteen can no longer accept notes \$20 and above due to change issues.

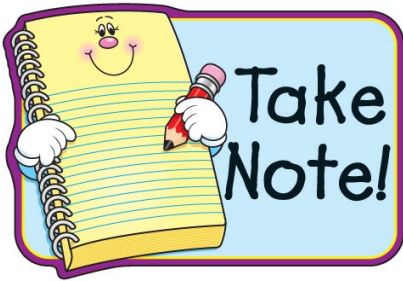
