
Slowly some places are starting to open again.




School is open again.

Anyone who is feeling sick needs to stay at home so they don't get others sick.




At school we will need to wash our hands lots for 20 seconds to clean the germs off.




Some parts of school will be closed.

The kitchen and canteen will be closed.







We will have to clean toys and iPads after we use them.

There will be signs to help teachers and helpers do this.




We will not be allowed to have side hugs or hold hands at school.






The teachers will help us all to stay safe

We may feel worried or confused. When we are worried or confused we could:


- Get a funny feeling in our tummy,
