Good afternoon!

Today the Premier Daniel Andrews announced that the current Victorian Lockdown would be extended for an additional 7 days with one change to schooling.

The advice we have received from the Department of Education is that: Students with disabilities who can't learn from home due to vulnerability or family stress are allowed to attend onsite learning at their school.

**This means that if your child is unable to learn in the home environment due to vulnerability or family stress, they are able to attend school onsite as of tomorrow.**

For staffing purposes, please inform the school if you intend to send your child to school tomorrow for onsite learning. School phones and email will be monitored. Phones will also be monitored from 8am tomorrow.

School buses will resume tomorrow, Wednesday the 21<sup>st</sup>.

**For those community members attending onsite:**

The most important action school communities can take to reduce the risk of transmission of coronavirus (COVID-19), is to ensure **that any unwell adult, child and young person remains at home.**

When onsite we ask that, everyone continue to follow the social distancing, hand sanitising and handwashing requirements of the school. We thank everyone for their continued cooperation in this area.

Staying home when ill, regular hand hygiene and social distancing remain the most effective way of stopping the spread of the virus.

**Check in with the school QR code.**

Any parent or adult visiting the school is required to check in via the QR code available at the front office.

### **Facemasks**

Staff and visitors to the school are required to wear facemasks. In certain circumstances, an individual may be exempt from wearing a face covering. Please inform the office if you believe you are exempt.

The advice we have received from the Department of Education in relation to students is that:

*All students over 12 are to wear a facemask except when their disability or mental health condition prevents them from wearing a face covering.*

We will be supporting students to wear a mask when possible.
