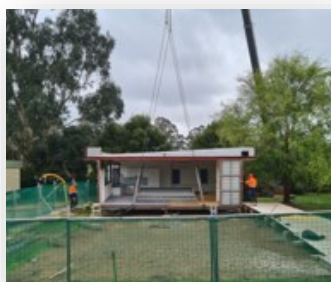
Welcome back to term 4!

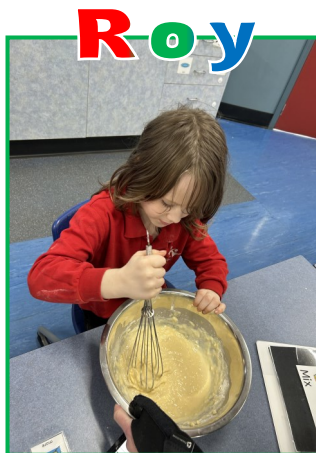
## Room 4

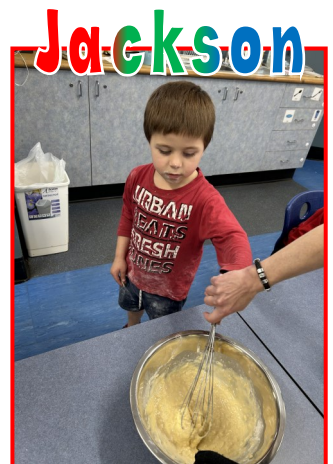

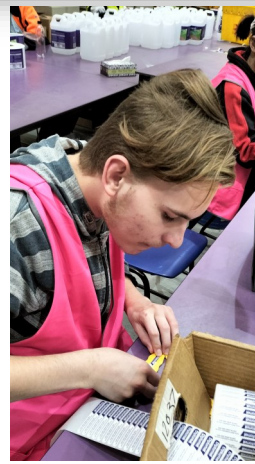
